

COMENTÁRIO GERAL

As questões referentes ao texto inicial estavam bem formuladas e acessíveis, já as questões 35, 36 e 39 que também envolviam interpretação de texto podem ser consideradas muito acima do nível a ser aplicadas a alunos de Ensino Médio. Os assuntos gramaticais abordados: uso do sufixo “ness” para formação de substantivos e conjunções (linking words) apresentaram questões padrões e bem elaboradas diferentemente da questão 40 que abordava o Present Perfect a qual trazia frases de interpretação duvidosa e erros de grafia que não é mais comum se encontrar em vestibulares.

Prova de qualidade técnica questionável.

Emirates Flies The World To Brazil

Emirates, the international Dubai-based airline, made history on Monday when EK261 took off from Dubai International Airport en-route to Sao Paulo, Brazil; representing the first ever non-stop flight between the Middle East and South America.

Emirates is using its technically advanced Boeing 777-200LR on the route, with Brazil becoming the 60th country and Sao Paulo the 94th destination on the airline's rapidly expanding network. Passengers from over 12 countries, including China, Japan, South Korea, India, Malaysia and Australia, joined the first flight to Sao Paulo after connecting through Dubai from other Emirates flights.

His Highness Sheikh Ahmed bin Saeed Al-Maktoum, Chairman and Chief Executive, Emirates Airline & Group said: "Today marks an important milestone for Emirates; not only is it our first gateway in South America, but it means we now fly non-stop to six continents from Dubai."

On board the first flight from Dubai to Sao Paulo was His Excellency Flavio Moreira Sapha, the Brazilian Ambassador to the United Arab Emirates.

Passengers travelling on the Dubai – Sao Paulo route will enjoy unrivalled in-flight service, including eight luxurious private suites in First Class, 42 of its latest lie-flat seats in Business, and generous space for 216 passengers in Economy.

Departing Dubai at 10:00 hrs, the flight time was 15 hours and 30 minutes with an arrival time at Sao Paulo Guarulhos International Airport of 18:30 hrs on the same day. The return flight, EK262, departs Sao Paulo at 01:25 hrs and arrives in Dubai at 23:05 hrs on the same day. Emirates flies five times weekly from Dubai to Malta via Larnaca in Cyprus, on Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays on the Boeing 777-200.

Comentário das questões

Questão 33

B

Comentário: No quarto parágrafo do texto consta a informação desta alternativa a qual afirma que o Embaixador brasileiro nos Emirados Árabes estava a bordo do primeiro vôo de Dubai para São Paulo.

Questão 34

E

Comentário: Utilizando a técnica “scanning”, isto é, fazendo uma busca no texto verifica-se que o número de pessoas a bordo do vôo e as condições do tempo durante o vôo não estão no texto, enquanto que as outras informações podem ser encontradas facilmente.

Questão 35

D

Comentário: Questão que pode estar além dos conhecimentos de alunos de Ensino Médio. Seria necessário um nível adiantado de aprendizado da Língua Inglesa para que a grande maioria dos candidatos resolvesse esta questão que pede para identificar a sentença que está fora de contexto na passagem.

Questão 36

E

Comentário: Mostrando falta de criatividade, esta questão é idêntica à anterior, exigindo do candidato um nível de conhecimento de Inglês acima daquele aplicado no Ensino Médio.

Questão 37

A

Comentário: O sufixo “ness” transforma alguns adjetivos em substantivos. Observe os pares incorretos: “poor-poverty”(pobre-pobreza), “wealthy-wealth”(rico-riqueza), “real-reality”(real-realidade).

Questão 38

B

Comentário: Questão que aborda as conjunções (Linking Words), muito abordadas durante as aulas. “In addition” e “Moreover” são sinônimas e significam “além disso”.

Questão 39

D

Comentário: Novamente uma questão de nível muito elevado, na qual candidatos que não possuem conhecimento aprofundado tiveram grande dificuldade na sua resolução. É necessário compreender profundamente o contexto para escolher a alternativa correta que o complete adequadamente.

Questão 40

E

Comentário: O enunciado desta questão pede para identificar as frases que apresentam o uso correto do Present Perfect, tempo verbal usado para expressar ações que aconteceram em um passado indeterminado ou ações que começaram no passado e se prolongam até o presente. As frases 1 e 2 estão corretas vejamos os erros das demais:

Frase 3: Estranhamente o único erro está na grafia do verbo “written” escrito apenas com um “T”, pois Jane pode ter começado a escrever o livro e ainda o está escrevendo.

Frase 4: Tempo determinado “last year”.

Frase 5: A palavra “Lice” é o plural de “Louse”(piolho) portanto deveria ser usado “have”.

Frase 6: Tempo determinado “a week ago”

Frase 7: A palavra “Men” é o plural de “Man”(homem)portanto deveria ser usado “have”.
